CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background of the Apprenticeship

Bengkalis State Polytechnic also has 10 (Ten) Study Programs D-IV among others: Road and Bridge Planning Engineering, Production and Maintenance Engineering, Electric Engineering, Engineering Technology, Shipping

Architecture, Software Engineering, Information Systems Security, International Business Administration, Public Financial Accounting, Digital Business, English for professional and business communication.

Polytechnic state of Bengkalis has a responsibility to advance human resources, especially in achieving student quality.
