The efforts of the Community and Village Empowerment Service are to provide regulations on the implementation of the tasks of the Regent and local officials as well as the Community and Village Empowerment Service. The factor facing the obstacle to the performance of the Village Community Empowerment Service in the Bengkalis Regency Accountability Report is the delay in the Village setting the APBDes because they have to wait for new regulations and other obstacles, weather factors, problems with village officials and village human resources.
