ABSTRACT

This study is entitled "The Impact of the Effectiveness of Increasing Non-Tax State Revenue (PNBP) on Financial Performance in Vocational Colleges" which aims to analyze PNBP sources, evaluate the achievement of PNBP targets, and identify the impact of the effectiveness of increasing PNBP on the financial performance of Bengkalis State Polytechnic.
