CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background of Apprenticeship

State Polytechnic of Bengkalis is one of the state polytechnics located in Bengkalis, Riau, Indonesia. State Polytechnic of Bengkalis is the first polytechnic in Riau that was established in 2000. Through the Gema Bahri foundation, its name for the first time was "*Politeknik Perkapalan Bengkalis*". On July 29th, 2011, the Bengkalis Polytechnic officially became a state university with the name State Polytechnic of Bengkalis through the Regulation of The Minister of National Education (Permendiknas) No.28 of 2011 concerning the Establishment of the Organization and Working Procedures of the State Polytechnic of Bengkalis. On December 26th, 2011, State Polytechnic of Bengkalis was inaugurated by the Minister of Education and Culture of the Republic of Indonesia.

State Polytechnic of Bengkalis has 18 (eighteen) Study Programs consisting of 10 (ten) D3 (Applied Bachelor) Study Programs in the Shipping Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Civil Engineering, Informatics Engineering, Engineering, Electrical Nautical, Shipping Commercial Management, Business English, and Business Administration Departments, and 8 (eight) D4 (Applied Bachelor) Study Programs which include Production and Maintenance Mechanical Engineering, International Business Administration, Public Financial Accounting, Electrical Engineering, Road and Bridge Planning Engineering, Information Systems Security Engineering, English for Business and Professional Communication, and Software Engineering.

State Polytechnic of Bengkalis as a vocational education institution is committed to creating graduates who not only master the theory, but are also able to apply knowledge in the real world of work. This is realized through the implementation of the apprenticeship program, which is part of the compulsory curriculum in the International Business Administration study program. Apprenticeship aims to provide direct experience to students in order to
